

Health and Safety Advisory: Jolet Ventures LLC (DBA 710 Labs)

January 5, 2023 — The Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR), in conjunction with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), is issuing a health and safety advisory due to the identification of potentially unsafe levels of Total Yeast and Mold contamination in Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim) packaged and transferred by Jolet Ventures LLC (doing business as 710 Labs). The CDPHE and DOR deem it a threat to public health and safety when marijuana is found to contain levels of Total Yeast and Mold above the acceptable limits established in Colorado Marijuana Rule 4-115.

Through an investigation, the DOR has identified Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim) from packages derived from Harvest Batches packaged by Jolet Ventures LLC (403R-00132) that contained levels of contaminants above acceptable limits for Total Yeast and Mold. The Retail Marijuana flower packages were sold by the six following stores:

- Big River Bend LLC DBA Unity Rd Cannabis Shop (402R-00588) located at 1537 Pearl St., Suite B, Boulder, CO
- Green Man Colorado LLC DBA Trees (402R-00373) located at 7289 East Hampden Ave., Denver, CO
- High Country Supply LLC DBA Colorado Harvest Company (402R-00317) located at 11002 East Yale Ave., Aurora, CO
- High Country Supply LLC DBA Colorado Harvest Company (402R-00077) located at 1178 South Kalamath St., Denver, CO
- High Country Supply LLC DBA Colorado Harvest Company (402R-00078) located at 1568 South Broadway, Denver, CO
- Jet Black Enterprises LLC DBA Leiffa (402R-00915) located at 6900 West Colfax Ave., Lakewood, CO

Consumers who have this affected marijuana in their possession should destroy it or return it to the Retail Marijuana Store from which it was purchased for proper disposal. Consumers who experience adverse health effects from consuming the marijuana flower should seek medical attention immediately and report the event to the Marijuana Enforcement Division by submitting an MED Reporting Form.

All affected marijuana has a label affixed to the container that, at a minimum, indicates the license number of the Regulated Marijuana Business that cultivated the marijuana and the Harvest Batch number assigned to the marijuana. Consumers should check the label of their Retail Marijuana flower for the following Retail Marijuana Cultivation license number and Harvest Batch number.
