

Health and Safety Advisory: MJ Durango LLC (dba Durango Cannabis Company)

March 20, 2023 - The Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR), in conjunction with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) is issuing a Health and Safety Advisory due to the identification of potentially unsafe levels of Total Yeast and Mold and Aspergillus contamination in pre-rolled marijuana and infused pre-rolled marijuana (commonly referred to as joints and blunts) produced by Retail Marijuana Cultivation Facility MJ Durango LLC (doing business as Durango Cannabis Company). The CDPHE and DOR deem it a threat to public health and safety when marijuana is found to have Total Yeast and Mold and Aspergillus levels above acceptable limits established in Colorado Marijuana Rule 4-115.

Through an investigation, the DOR has identified Production Batches of pre-rolled marijuana and infused pre-rolled marijuana (commonly referred to as joints and blunts) produced by MJ Durango LLC that contained levels of contaminants above the acceptable limits for Total Yeast and Mold and Aspergillus. Additionally, the investigation has identified Production Batches that were improperly submitted for testing. As a precautionary measure, Production Batches created during that time are also included in this advisory. In collaboration with the Marijuana Enforcement Division (MED), MJ Durango LLC (dba Durango Cannabis Company) initiated a voluntary recall for the affected Production Batches. These contaminated and improperly tested batches were sold to consumers between 10/19/2022 and 02/02/2023 at approximately 30 stores across the state.

Consumers who have this affected marijuana in their possession should destroy it or return it to the Retail Marijuana Store from which it was purchased for proper disposal. Consumers who experience adverse health effects from consuming the pre-rolled marijuana or infused pre-rolled marijuana should seek medical attention immediately and report the event to the Marijuana Enforcement Division by submitting the MED Reporting Form.

All affected marijuana has a label affixed to the container that, at a minimum, indicates the license number of the Retail Marijuana Cultivation that cultivated the marijuana and the Production Batch number assigned to the pre-rolled marijuana and infused pre-rolled marijuana. Consumers should check the label of their pre-rolled marijuana and infused pre-rolled marijuana for the following product names, license number, and Production Batch numbers.
