

March 31, 2021 - The Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR), in conjunction with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), and TZ Financial, LLC, is issuing a health and safety advisory due to the identification of potentially unsafe levels of Cadmium, a metals contaminant, on Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim) produced by TZ Financial, LLC (DBA High Country Healing) The CDPHE and DOR deem it a threat to public health and safety when marijuana is found to have levels of Cadmium above the acceptable limits established in MED Rule 4-115.

Consumers who have these affected products in their possession should return them to TZ Financial, LLC (DBA High Country Healing) for proper disposal. Consumers who experience adverse health effects from consuming the product should seek medical attention immediately and report the event to the store from which they purchased the product.

Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim) derived from these Harvest Batches were sold between December 2020 and March 2021.

All affected marijuana should have a label affixed to the container that, at a minimum, indicates the license number of the Retail Marijuana Business that cultivated the marijuana as well as the Harvest Batch assigned to the marijuana. Consumers should check the label of their Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim) for the following license number and Harvest Batch.
