



Health and Safety Advisory: Kind Care of Colorado, LLC dba Kind Care of Colorado

June 12, 2023 - The Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR), in conjunction with the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), is issuing a Health and Safety Advisory due to the identification of potentially unsafe levels of Total Yeast and Mold on Medical and Retail Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim and pre-rolls, commonly referred to as joints) sold by **Kind Care of Colorado, LLC dba Kind Care of Colorado**. The CDPHE and DOR deem it a threat to public health and safety when marijuana is found to have Total Yeast and Mold above the acceptable limits established in [Colorado Marijuana Rule 4-115](#).

Through an investigation that included the submission of test samples, DOR has identified Regulated Marijuana flower (bud/shake/trim and pre-rolls) sold at Kind Care of Colorado, LLC that contained levels of contaminants above acceptable limits for Total Yeast and Mold. The contaminated marijuana, identified through the license numbers and Harvest Batches listed below, was sold to patients and consumers between **February 10, 2023, and June 06, 2023, at:**

Consumers who have this affected marijuana in their possession should destroy it or return it to the Regulated Marijuana Store from which it was purchased for proper disposal. If consumers experience adverse health effects from consuming the Regulated Marijuana, they should seek medical attention immediately and report the event to the Marijuana Enforcement Division by submitting a [MED Reporting Form](#).

All affected marijuana has a label affixed to the container that, at a minimum, indicates the license number of the Regulated Marijuana Store that sold the marijuana, the date it was sold, and the Harvest Batch number assigned to the marijuana. Consumers should check the label of their container of Regulated Marijuana for the following license numbers and Harvest Batch numbers.
