July 9, 2020 - Kinfolk Farms, LLC, in coordination with the Colorado Department of Revenue (DOR) and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), are issuing an immediate health and safety advisory due to the identification of potentially unsafe pesticide residues on retail marijuana produced by **Kinfolk Farms, LLC, dba Kinfolk Farms**. CDPHE and DOR deem it a threat to public health and safety when pesticides that have not been approved for use on marijuana by the Colorado Department of Agriculture are applied to regulated marijuana.

Consumers who have these affected products in their possession should return them to the retail store from which they were purchased so they can be properly disposed of. Consumers who experience adverse health effects from consuming the product should seek medical attention immediately and report the event to the store from which they purchased the product. All affected marijuana has a label affixed to the container that at a minimum indicates the license number of the retail marijuana business that cultivated the marijuana. Consumers should check the label of their retail marijuana for the following license number and harvest batch numbers:
