OTHER DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS		
Use of an Online Platform Provider [Rule 3-615(F)(2)]		
 If using an online platform provider for taking delivery orders: Must require the patient/consumer to choose a Store before displaying the price of MJ for delivery. The Store must receive verification that there has not already been a delivery of MJ to the same private residence within the same business day via the online provider. 		
Age Restrictions [Rule 3-615(F)(1)]		
Medical MJ Age Restrictions: No Medical Marijuana delivery orders to patients ages 18 - 20 [Rule 3-615(F)(1)		

Daily Delivery Limits [Rule 3-615(G)(8)]		
 Medical: No more than two ounces of Medical Marijuana, 8 grams of Medical Marijuana Concentrate, or Medical Marijuana Products containing more than 20,000 milligrams of THC to a patient in a single business day. Retail: No more than one ounce of Retail Marijuana, 8 grams of Retail Marijuana Concentrate, or Retail Marijuana Products containing more than ten 80 milligram servings of THC to a customer in a single business day.
